BIOHAZARD EXPOSURE?

BIOHAZARDS INCLUDE:

- Human materials
- Potentially infectious agents
- Recombinant or synthetic nucleic acids

EXPOSURES INCLUDE:

- Sharps injury (needlestick, cut, scrape, scratch exposure)
- Animal bite or cut exposure
- Potential inhalation of biohazardous aerosols
- Splash to face, eyes, mouth or nose

**Immediately
Clean Wound/
Exposure Site**

Wash with soap and water or flush
with water (if mucous membrane)
for 15 minutes

**Get Immediate
Medical Attention**
