Ron Hays (PhD, University of California, Riverside, Psychology) is Professor of Medicine at UCLA and a Senior Health Scientist at RAND. He is one of the Principal Investigators for CAHPS®, a project that has developed measures to assess consumer evaluations of hospitals, nursing homes, group practices, and individual physicians as well as tools to report these assessments to health care providers and consumers. Dr. Hays has published over 350 research articles and 31 book chapters. He is a former editor-in-chief of *Quality of Life Research* and former deputy editor of *Medical Care*.
